Welcome to the 2021-22 school year, which is full-time, in-person learning. We are looking forward to seeing our kindergarteners tomorrow, as well as our preschoolers on Monday, September 20th.

THANK YOU so much for your patience, flexibility, and understanding as we learn what before/after school systems work best for the McKinley site. We appreciate you!

Late Start (*NEW):

Our Wednesday 1-hour late start schedule starts this week on Wednesday, September 15th. School will start on 10 AM on late start days and there will be no supervision prior to 9:50 AM.

Immunizations & Vaccinations (*UPDATED):

More free school immunization and COVID-19 vaccination opportunities are now open to you and your family.

It is so important to get those school immunizations complete. If your child received immunizations over the summer, make sure to update our school nurse. Students without required immunizations or a valid exemption will not be allowed to attend school, as the law requires.

A COVID-19 vaccine is not required for students to attend school, but they are available for free to those 12 and up, and that includes students and families. Get more details on our website or in that Sunday newsletter on 9/12/21.

Kindergarten Information (*NEW):

Below is the kindergarten student/family specific robocall that went out on Friday afternoon.

I wanted to take a minute to remind you that school starts for kindergarten students this Monday, Sept. 13.

Our Fawcett team is so excited to welcome and make our school family complete. Students who are riding the bus will enter each morning from the main doors and students getting dropped off by a family member will enter from our north door. Please line up in your car facing east on E 37th Street.



With our Covid-19 safety precautions in place, this year looks a little different than a typical school year. While we would love to welcome parents and guardians into our classrooms on the first day, we instead ask that you say your good-bye's outside.

I want to assure you that our Fawcett team is looking out for each and every kindergartener to make sure they feel safe and welcome in their new school. We will take good care of them.

Also, I am excited to share our newest addition to our kindergarten and Fawcett team. Mrs. Eileen Prather is our kindergarten teacher for room 2. She comes with an extensive knowledge and experiences in early childhood education. She is so excited to meet the students assigned to room 2 and get to know the families too! She will be greeting her students at the door on Monday morning.

Here are a few reminders to start the day:

- Please have your child wear his or her mask starting when they get on the bus or when they reach school property.

Drop-Off/Pick-Up & Bus Zone:

It is important, for the safety of all, and to be cognizant to the McKinley neighbors, to follow these important drop-off / pick-up expectations:

There will be no supervision in the morning prior to 8:50 AM on M/T/Th/F. On Wednesdays, no supervision prior to 9:50 AM.

Student drop off, pick up directions

- Drop off and pick up students on E. 37th St. (Blue X)
- Don't park on E. 37th St. Please follow the cones and signage placed on E. 37th St. during drop off and pick up times.
- Avoid dropping off or picking up your student in the front of the building on E. McKinley Ave. This area is reserved for buses only.





- Drop-off and pick-up will occur on E 37th Street to the north of the school. Please follow the cones, signs, and staff direction, as there is no parking on E. 37th Street (directly north of the school) or on the curb closest to the school on E. McKinley Ave., as that is where our busses will pick-up/drop-off.
- E. McKinley Ave. (on the school side) will be for busses only. Please do not drop-off, pick-up, or park here.
- The only crosswalk will be on the corner of E. 37th Street & E. McKinley Ave. Please adhere to direction of the crossing guard at this location.
- School is out each day at 3:30 PM.

COVID-19 Relief Funds (*NEW):

Tacoma Public Utilities wants our school families to know help is available for those struggling to pay utility bills. Free Meals in 2021-22 School Year & Other Meals Updates:

While meals for TPS students are free again this year, we will ask families to fill out <u>Household Information</u> <u>Surveys</u> that replace the Free and Reduced-Price Meal Applications. Instructions on completing the survey will be shared with you soon.

Again this year, breakfast and lunch are free for all students. We are returning to more traditional hot lunches this fall. We are still working to confirm menus and there may be limited options at the start of the year, but we will introduce more options as soon as we can.

Students will eat breakfast in the classroom, and they will sit with their classroom group in the cafeteria for lunch, staying physically distanced as much as possible. More information can be found at: https://www.tacomaschools.org/departments/nutrition.

Beyond the Bell (*UPDATED):
